

Review of “Whose”

Steps:

1. Decide what belongs to what:

I apologized to the man. I hit his car. = **man/car**

2. Put the words together with a blank in the middle: **man _____ car**

3. Add “whose”:
man whose car

4. Now write the sentence: **I apologized to the man whose car I hit.**
