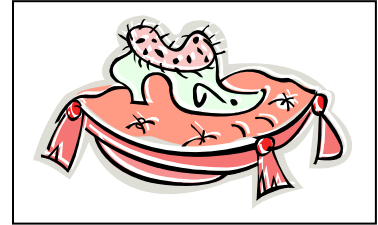

An Assessment on *There is/There are*
